Bird Bingo

Go for a walk round the local fields and spot these birds that can be seen all year round in the countryside around Pury End and Paulerspury! You don't need binoculars, but you will need wellies!

Suggested walk (approx. 4.5km / 1.5 hours at bird spotting pace!)

From St James the Great Church in Paulerspury walk towards the small green and turn right into Park Lane. Walk towards Park Farm and at the path junction just before the farm turn left. Keep the hedge on your Right until, just before a wooded area there is a gap in the hedge that allows you to turn left on an old concrete track. Follow this concrete track all the way to the Plumpton End Road.

Turn left along the road. When road bends sharp right, keep heading towards Plumpton End. Before reaching Plumpton End turn left on a signed footpath that leads you down through fields before crossing a bridge over a small stream. Cross this then head slightly uphill towards the houses in Paulerspury. Follow the path between the houses to emerge onto Lumber Lane.

Turn left and follow the road back to the junction with Park Lane on your left and the church ahead of you.
